6. **Planning Together and Community Engagement** – A Sedgwick will circulate his report following the BDC Town & Parish Liaison Meeting. Regarding the Functional Clusters in Babergh, Councillors agreed that it was not logical to work with the large Boxford group, but better to work with the smaller Nayland group. I Reece will write to the Chairs of Nayland, Assington, Leavenheath and Polstead Parish Councils with a view to initiating discussions. A Sedgwick will prepare a draft.
7. **Heavy vehicles travelling through the parish** – this will be dealt with on the main Parish Council agenda in consultation with the County Council                    nch.
8. **Any Other Planning Matters** – The container outside 14 Sudbury Road is still in place but BDC have confirmed that they expect it to be moved shortly.

A Sedgwick reported on a BDC presentation he attended regarding travellers. The focus from SCC will be to provide 3 sites in the areas highlighte on their map based on their experience with unauthorised sites occurring near the main roads, and will not be in this area. There is nothing the Parish Council can do to assist but wish the well with the project.
