

## **Report to Stoke by Nayland Street Light Working Group**

### **Street Lighting Proposals - Budget Costing**

As agreed at the Working Group meeting on 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016, Jeremy has held discussions with Richard Webster at Suffolk County Council regarding estimated costs for the proposals endorsed by the Working Group.

The estimate has been based on the following assumptions:

- (1) Replacement of 12 existing street lights with new arms and 35 watt LED street lamps with soft white lighting (identical to the sample on show at the public exhibition), complete with isolators, photocells and timers, all installed to latest power and street lighting regulations and standards.
- (2) Removal of a further 14 street lights, including disconnection of power supplies and removal existing arms and lamps from existing UKPN electricity and BT telephone poles.

The work required at each light location has been individually assessed and priced. The estimated totals are as follows

- For 12 replacement lights - £9,898
- For 14 disconnections and removals - £5,026

The estimate is exclusive of VAT.

### **Proposal**

The Working Group is invited to endorse the following recommendation to Parish Council:-

**That the street lighting proposals agreed by the Working Group at its meeting of 27<sup>th</sup> June 2016 be adopted, along with a budget estimate of £15,000 (plus VAT).**
